

Dorris' Two TDs Spark Irish Win

Ursuline High's grid machine, prepping for next Saturday night's "big" game with Chaney, tripped a highly-touted Canton Central team, 12-6, before some 4,000 fans at Rayen Stadium last night.

Billy Dorris, Ursuline's do-scorer both touchdowns for the Irish on keeper-plays covering 11 and eight yards.

Canton Central hit paydirt first, recovering on Ursuline fumble at the Irish 34 to set up the marker. On the first play from that spot, Tony Vitale found a wide hole up the middle

and traveled the 34 yards for the score.

Ursuline came back in the second period with the equalizer as Dorris carried a fourth down and four-to-go maneuver the final 11 yards. The Irish defense looked good in the first half, which ended 6-6.

Dorris, following the opening kickoff, guided his team to the clinching marker. Ed Maloney and Vince Julian got off key runs that earned a first down at Central's eight. From that spot, Dorris ran wide on another keeper for the touchdown. Maloney gained plenty of yardage for the Irish.

Ursuline had 17 first downs to seven for Central.
